Golf Tournament 2020 **Update** (Event chair Worthy brother *Terry Maher*)

- (GK Joe Palko) Special Thank you to Terry Maher for Chairing our outing and the golf committee Eric Pasarin, Mike Pughes, Matt Pasick, Mike Potochnik and Tony Morano
- Despite significant challenges, our recent Golf Tournament event was a huge success! We are now better positioned to charitably assist more members of our community & Church as needed
- The website created and maintained by Eric Pasarin served not only the tournament quite well, but also a multiple of other important Council initiatives. The site will continue to be adapted to meet our fundraising needs going forward. (or even drive membership functions?) Nice Work Eric!
- We have raised over \$20,000 in funds with \$8000 in expenses netting over \$12000. Last years net was \$7800 for a 60% improvement. This is a remarkable effort considering the many challenges posed by COVID to our council and our 45 sponsors. Expense payments have cleared, gifts and prizes have all been delivered
- We are looking to repeat our event next year in October due in large part to the favorable weather and course conditions that we experienced. Heritage were gracious hosts and offered us better value on costs when compared to previous events at other country clubs. (*ie* \$2200 cheaper than Hasentree last year) Therefore, we booked with Heritage for our next outing on October 5th 2021.

- Moving the Golf Tournament from May 2021 to October 2021 does not impact our current budget - we will continue to manage our expenses to the approved FY2021 budget.
